

10 DAYS HOLY LAND

TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 01: USA/TEL AVIV Depart from USA to Tel Aviv. (Meals in Flight)

DAY 02: TEL AVIV/NETANYA Arrive in Tel Aviv. Transfer to our hotel in Netanya for dinner & overnight. (D)

DAY 03: NETANYA/CAESAREA/MOUNT CARMEL/MEGIDDO/ NAZARETH After breakfast we depart Netanya and proceed north along the Mediterranean Sea and stop in Caesarea, the ancient port built by King Herod the Great. We continue to Elijah's Cave, then on to Mount Carmel where Elijah battled the prophets of Baal. Continue to the Valley of Armageddon and the historic military fortress of Megiddo that controlled the highway between Egypt and Mesopotamia. We proceed to Nazareth, to see the Church of the Annunciation. We will visit Cana, to see the church where Jesus had his first miracle, then continue to Tiberias for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

Day 04: DAN/CAESAREA PHILLIPPI Today we will drive north to visit Dan and Caesarea Philippi, where the great confession of Peter took place, and see the head water of the River Jordan. In the afternoon we will visit the traditional baptismal site on the Jordan River. Then back to Tiberias for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 05: AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE. Today we start by sailing on the Sea of Galilee. We will visit Capernaum, Jesus' second home. There we will see the second century Synagogue and the House of Peter's mother-in-law. We also visit Tabgha, the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes, the Mount of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Then return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 06: MOUNT TABOR/BET SHEAN/JERICHO This morning we depart Tiberias and drive to Mount Tabor, the traditional site of the Transfiguration. Then we travel south to Bet Shean, where the Philistines killed King Saul. Then continue down through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the world's oldest inhabited city. We proceed through the Judean Wilderness and view the breath-taking Valley of Shadow of Death, then up to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight (B/D)

DAY 07: MOUNT OF OLIVES/ MOUNT ZION/BETHLEHEM This morning we begin on the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. We visit the Chapel of the Ascension, The Church of Pater Noster and walk along Palm Sunday Road stopping at Dominus Flevit and the Garden of Gethsemane. Here we visit the Church of All Nations, which stands on the Rock of the Agony. View the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. Drive to Mount Zion and visit the House of Caiaphas, "The High Priest," where Jesus was brought on the night He was arrested. We will visit the site of the Last Supper and the Tomb of David. We then proceed to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus. We will visit the Church of the Nativity, Manger Square and Shepherd's Fields. We return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 08: EIN KAREM/VALLEY OF EILAH/BETHANY/QUMRAN/DEAD SEA

We will drive to Ein Karem, to see the church built over the place where John the Baptist was born. We will travel to the Valley of Eilah, where King David killed Goliath. In the afternoon, we will visit Bethany, the site where Mary, Martha and Lazarus lived and the tomb of Lazarus. We will travel to Qumran, the site of the discovery of Dead Sea scrolls. We continue to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. We'll stop briefly at the shores of the Dead Sea for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 09: JERUSALEM/BETHFAGE Today is a walking tour of the "Old City" of Jerusalem. We visit the Western Wall, walk through the excavations, and have a period of devotions on the southern steps to the temple area. We will see Mount Moriah and the Dome of the Rock, where tradition holds that Abraham took Isaac to be sacrificed. We then proceed to the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of the Flagellation and Pilate's Judgment Hall. We will walk the Via Dolorosa, the Way of the Cross, passing through picturesque native bazaars to reach the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Next, we visit Bethfage, where Jesus mounted the donkey to begin His triumphal ride into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. Our day ends at the Garden Tomb and Golgotha, (also known as Skull Hill). We return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 10: TEL AVIV/USA Depart for our flight back to the USA. We bring back with us memories of an exciting and rewarding time in the Holy Land. This region will be more understood as we read history, scripture and current events.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip air transportation from the USA will be via economy class jet service aboard IATA and ARC carriers, utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups flying together on the entire itinerary. International flight times will be confirmed to the travel agent at least 45 days prior to departure. Airline tickets must be finalized and issued a minimum of 30 days prior to departure. Once tickets have been issued, they cannot be refunded or exchanged and are subject to cancellation penalties. Your flight times are subject to change without advance notice. Priority Travel & Tours, Inc. is not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules, and does not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from delays. **LUGGAGE:** Portage and handling of ONE piece of baggage per person is included. On airlines, the free baggage allowance is according to the size and not weight. Apart from the usual accessories (handbag, camera, etc.) each passenger may have ONE piece of carry-on luggage. Airline liability for passenger's baggage is stated on contract included on all tickets and shall not exceed the actual loss, subject to proof. Baggage is at "Owner's Risk" throughout the tour offered from and return to US Departure City.
